#### **Attendance**

We do insist on the NHS policy of a 48-hour period of absence following the last bout sickness or diarrhoea to prevent the spread of bugs. If a child is on antibiotics, these can be administered in school providing we have signed parent / carer permission. Medical appointments should mean children missing school for the minimal amount of time possible – attending school before and / or after as appropriate.

The school doors open at 8:45am and children who arrive after 8:55am are late. The first part of the morning includes Early Morning Work and establishing the routine for the day ahead, it is vital children are in school for this to ensure they can prepare for the best day possible.
