Dear Parents and Carers,

Wow! We have had an amazing day in school today with a real buzz created by our visiting poet Dave Bowden who worked with Years 4, 5 and 6. Dave was so impressed with our children: their creativity, their ideas, their love for their school and village and their performances! Well done to all children involved, especially those whose poems were selected to be performed. We hope to get a selection of these onto our website soon so watch this space!

In other exciting news, we had our visit meeting to discuss the plans to improve and extend our school. A further meeting is scheduled for next week with the architects, design team, engineers, etc. Once the first set of plans are drawn and finalised, we will of course share them with you and the community and then the planning permission process will start. Timelines are unknown as yet however I shall keep you constantly updated!

Daffodil class will have their opportunity in the spring term and Sunflower class in the summer term.

Finally, this week also saw the Y2 trip to Holdenby House which was another great success. The children had a fantastic day and learnt lots during their "Muddy Adventures" day.

Unfortunately, we have really struggled this week with staff absence due to Covid and other illnesses. Other schools are in the same position so finding good quality supply teachers has proved challenging! We have done our best to continue to offer a full curriculum with known, high-quality teachers for every class, this remains the case for next week too.

Remember that if your child has any covid symptoms, you should book them for a PCR test online via this link: [Get a free PCR test to check if you have coronavirus \(COVID-19\) - GOV.UK \(www.gov.uk\)](https://www.gov.uk/get-a-free-pcr-test-to-check-if-you-have-coronavirus) Updated guidance we received this week from Public Health Northamptonshire is not to give symptomatic children lateral flow tests, but to book a PCR test straightaway.

I will constantly review our risk assessment and will have to implement our contingency plans if numbers rise to 10% in any one class. Please be prepared for possible changes to parent Christmas events and performances. Fingers crossed we don't have to make changes but please watch this space!

Behaviour focus: Real Respect

Next week's focus is showing "Real Respect". I will be encouraging the children to hold doors open for others, give eye contact, greet each other and adults politely and asking, "How are you today?" and listening properly for the reply! This is all part of being a good member of our school community and society at large.

Christmas Mufti Day

A reminder that next Friday 3rd December is our "Christmas Mufti Day" where children can come to school in their own clothes (any kind of clothes, Christmassy or not!) On this day, we will be spending

time creating Christmas tree decorations for the All Saints Church Christmas tree festival and we will be having an assembly on Advent. Linked to this is “giving to others” and we would therefore request a donation of 50p or £1 for the McCarthy-Dixon Foundation which is a charity which has supported our school and many other schools across Northampton through lockdown with food parcels, breakfast boxes and laptops for children. We would like to repay this through collecting money for the charity on mufti day next week.

Y2 Phonics Screening

All children in Year 2 will complete their phonics screening next week with their class teacher (Mrs Levell or Miss Sparkes). The phonics screening check usually occurs in Year 1 but could not last year due to the coronavirus pandemic and school closures. Each child in Year 2 will work 1:1 with their teacher to read a series of words to check they have good phonic knowledge and can blend sounds together to form words. This is a simple check and will take between 4 and 9 minutes per child. Children who meet the expected standard in the check next week will not be re-assessed on their phonics in Year 2. Children who do not meet the expected standard in this round of checks will be re-assessed in the summer term. All parents will receive their child’s phonics check results with their end of year report.

EYFS Nativity Performance

We look forward to welcoming all the EYFS families who have booked tickets to see the Nativity performances. A reminder that **only 2 tickets per family** should be booked. There are some spaces left for the dress rehearsal on Friday 10th December at 9.30am, which can only be booked through the school office. This performance is suitable for attending with younger siblings. Reminder to complete important form

All the people who parents have identified as contacts on the school’s data sheet can collect children from school. If you know in advance there is going to be a change to who is going to collect your child after school, please write a note in your child’s green home-school book for their class teacher. The school understands that there can be last minute changes to the arrangements to pick up your children. To ensure only a parent/carer informs us of a change over the telephone, we have decided to implement a password system. If anyone calls the office to notify us of a change in who is collecting a child (someone other than the named contacts we have already), we will ask for your chosen password on the telephone. We will also ask the collecting adult for this password before handing over your child.
