

Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been a lovely week in school with the children really enthusiastic to be back into the swing of a full learning routine! TT Rockstars has created a real buzz in Key Stage Two, as has NumBots in Key Stage One. It is also lovely hearing of children being keen to write and do their homework! Year Three's Ancient Egyptian wow day on Monday was a real success – many thanks to the parent volunteers who joined us. Internet Safety Day on Tuesday was also very well-received and Simon Aston was very complimentary about the behaviour and listening skills of our children.

COVID updates

Across the school, confirmed (via PCR or LFD test) cases remain low in children and staff. We have approximately 12 people across our school currently isolating due to being a confirmed covid case. Further children are isolating as a precaution if a family member has tested positive (although this is not in-line with current guidelines we would support this approach and will provide online learning.) Please help us to keep our case numbers low so children can keep learning and staff can keep working! If your child has any covid symptoms, please keep them at home and access a Lateral Flow Device (LFD) test as soon as possible.

The rules change AGAIN as of Monday...! From Monday onwards a minimum of 5 full days isolation could be all that is required if a person has a negative LFD test on the morning of days 5 AND day 6 AND has no high temperature. In this case, a child (or adult) could return to school on day 6.
